I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by Somerset County Council.

# Your Request:

- 1. How many people are employed to deal with FOI?
- 2. What is the budget for administering FOI?
- 3. Do you use case management software for FOI? If so, which one?
- 4. Do you publish a disclosure log?

### Our Response:

- How many people are employed to deal with FOI?
  Response: 4 people. 1 full time (37 hrs pw), 2 part time (21 & 32 hrs pw) plus one full time service manager with a wider remit (est. 12 hrs pw on FOI related activity).
- 2. What is the budget for administering FOI?

Response: £81,000 \*est.

- \*This sum includes actual figures for the full salary costs of the 3 dedicated FOI staff plus a proportion of the actual full salary costs of the manager (based on an estimate of time spent on FOI activity) and a nominal proportion the ICT system maintenance charge (as the system is used for customer feedback and subject access requests in addition to FOI requests).
- Do you use case management software for FOI? If so, which one? Response: Yes, iCasework (<u>https://www.icasework.com/</u>)
- 4. Do you publish a disclosure log?
